	<i>Parents can register for the schools based on their circumstances and preferences.</i>
	<i>Please check school's/council websites for more info such as - open days, exam info and catchment policy. You may also check school's website for what facilities they offer, visit school on open days and speak to friends/families who are in the school. Please avoid taking views from parents who don't have their child in that grammar school.</i>
	<i>If you are not sure about an exam, you can book now but decide later in Sep to appear or not. You may also choose to notify your primary school for the exams dates i.e. when your child would be off from school. Most primary schools would suggest that you come to school after the exam. But you may decide as some of the locations are too far and child may be stressed out after the exam.</i>
	<i>Super-selective schools are the top grammar schools in the country (see telegraph and BBC league tables)</i>
	<i>Some schools offer IB syllabus which means that your child would have to take up one or two non-EU language until GCSE.</i>
	<i>Most of the schools/council would give you a score by Oct. Some schools such as St. Olave's give you result of Stage II by 1st March.</i>
	<i>The school preferences (Common application form) is submitted by end Oct to the local council. You should know by now what are your top 4-6 choices.</i>
	<i>You can move into the catchment by end Nov but it may vary from council to council (or by school). Please email them to get this info.</i>
	<i>Allocation day is 1st March 2020</i>
	<i>Private school exams happen in Jan and most of their registration happens around Sep-Oct. Please visit school's websites for further info. The schools generally preferred by our previous students are: Sevenoaks, Dulwich, Trinity, Alleyns, JAGS, Christ Hospital, Royal Russell, Whitgift, Haberdasher, Eton, Westminster, City of London Boys/Girls, Colfe and Bromley High.</i>
